## ThinLinc Clients for Computerome 2.0

**Thinlinc Client** is available from [Cendio download page](#).

Several users experience that **Gnome** UI/UX runs **very slow** in Thinlinc. It is recommended to use other alternatives, such as **Mate**. Loading **anaconda** module in your login environment *will* conflict with ThinLinc login, causing messages such as "Could not acquire name on the session bus". please ensure that your do not do this, if you plan to use ThinLinc.  
If you get the message "no password configured for VNC Auth", you need to select the following in the ThinLinc Client startup:
